The Health Service Executive (HSE) encourages regular testing for HIV and other STIs, but getting access to testing services isn't easy.

Public clinics like the Gay Men's Health Service (GMHS) on Baggot Street are at capacity, struggling to meet the demand for STI testing, treatment, vaccination and other vital services. Overcrowding and long waiting times are common.

With new diagnoses of HIV and other STIs at record levels, HSE needs to increase funding to support Ireland's public sexual health services, to expand clinic times, and to improve the facilities.

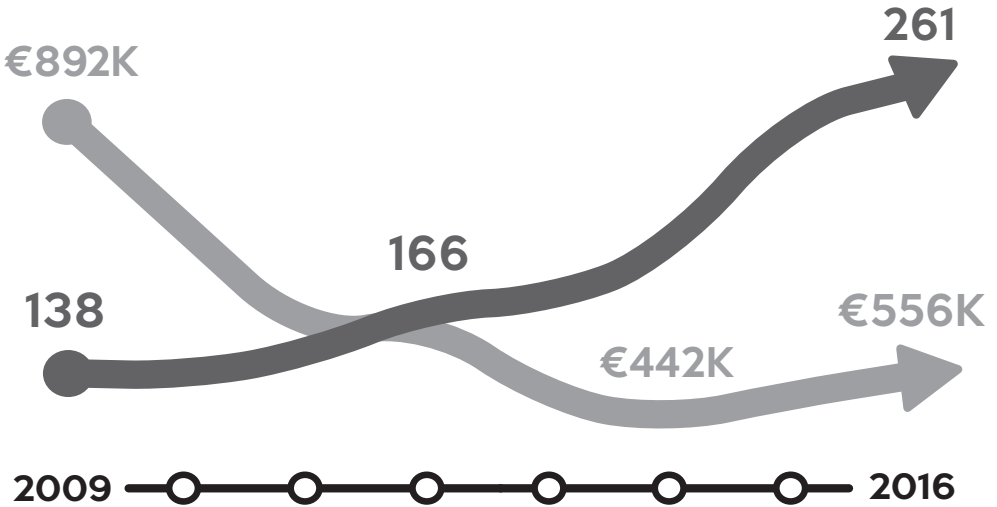
